Notice of Race

1. **Organizing Authority**
Segel- und Yachtclub Herrliberg, Seestrasse 110, CH-8704 Herrliberg
In co-operation with the Class Association JOKER
2. **Venue and Date**
The EURO Championship will be held from Thursday, September 30 to Sunday October 3, 2010 on the Lake of Zurich, near Herrliberg.
3. **Rules**
The regatta will be governed by:
 - 3.1 The "Rules", as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF.
 - 3.2 The Class Rules of the JOKER-Class.
4. **Eligibility**
 - 4.1 The competitors (entire crew) must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.
5. **Advertising**
 - 5.1 Advertising Category C will apply.
 - 5.2 Advertising of the Main Sponsor of the Event on the boats is possible.
6. **Entry**
 - 6.1 Entries shall be submitted on the enclosed Entry Form, completely filled out. The following documents shall be enclosed:

- Confirmation of Club Membership or Licence.
- Confirmation of the legitimacy for advertising Category C.
- Confirmation of the third-party liability insurance.

- 6.3 Deadline of Entries: Entries shall be received by the Organizing Authority no later than September 6, 2010 (postal stamp). Late entries will be accepted until September 20, 2010 against an increased Entry Fee..
- 6.4 Entry Fee: CHF 300.- (EUR 200.-) per Boat, to be paid in cash at Registration.
Late Entry Fee:: CHF 350.- (EUR 235.-)

7. **Schedule of Races**

- 7.2 Scheduled Races:
 - The Championship will be sailed with 10 valid races
 - To constitute the Championship at least 4 valid races must be sailed during the scheduled time.
 - On one day no more than 4 valid races will be sailed.

8. **Measurement**

- 8.1 Measurement checks will take place in the tent near the Clubhouse SYH
- 8.2 No first measurements will be carried out.

9. **Scoring**

- 9.1 The "Low Point Scoring System" of Appendix A of the RRS will apply.
- 9.2 Excluding worst scores: After 5 valid Races the worst score will be discarded. After 8 valid races, a second score will be excluded..
- 9.3 JOKER scoring factor: 1,5.

10. **Prizes**

- 10.1 The following prizes will be awarded:
 - Champion: Trophy „Joker European Open“ (to be returned for the next EURO)
 - Pointprizes for the first 3 boats
 - Souvenirs for each competitor.

11. Mooring and Parking

- 11.1 For every boat a suitable place will be provided. Arrangements of the harbour administrator must be respected.
- 11.2 Special parking lots will be marked for the trailers.
- 11.3 Campers may be parked near the Clubhouse.

12. Social Events

- 12.1 The following events will be organized:
 - Thursday Sep 30: Swiss Evening at the Club
 - Friday Oct 1: Food and Beverages at the Club
 - Saturday Oct 2: Official Joker-Evening (included in the Entry Fees)
- 12.2 Registration for these events shall be submitted on the Entry-Form.

13. Doping

- 13.1 Doping test may be conducted according to the guidelines of Antidoping Schweiz.

14. Liability and Insurance

- 14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 14.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event (min. 1,5 Mio CHF) and valid for racing.

15. Accommodation for foreign partizipants

The organizers will provide support to find low-budget accommodation. Please mention your request on the Entry-Form.
